## **PRESS RELEASE**

Members of the Kingston Police Department report the arrests of Clinton A. Padusnak of 349 Kripplebush Rd. Olive Bridge, N.Y. and Julian Wynkoop of 115 Kelder Highway Olive Bridge, N.Y.

On October 16, 2011 members of the Kingston Police Detective Division received a complaint of theft of a large quantity of specialized hardened copper that occurred at the Trolley Museum located at 89 E. Strand in the City of Kingston. An investigation was conducted that ultimately lead to the arrests of Clinton A. Padusnak and Julian Wynkoop. On November 15<sup>th</sup> 2011 Clinton Padusnak was arrested at the Kingston Police Department and charged with the Felony of Grand Larceny in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree and five counts of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the 5<sup>th</sup> degree. Padusnak was arraigned in Kingston City Court and remanded to the Ulster County Jail without bail.

On November 16<sup>th</sup> 2011 Julian Wynkoop was arrested at the Kingston Police Department and charged with Grand Larceny in the 3<sup>rd</sup> degree and six counts of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the 5<sup>th</sup> degree. Wynkoop is currently being held at the Kingston Police department awaiting arraignment in Kingston City Court.
